Qualifier: Bowl 4 games across 2 Pairs of Lanes. Bowl 2 games then move 1 pair (lanes 1-2 swap with 3-4, 5-6 with 7-8, etc.) within each division. Top 50% in each division will advance to Survivor Finals.

Survivor Finals: Bowl 1 game on a pair of lanes with others in your division - lanes are randomly assigned. Handicap will be added in the handicap divisions. The low person on each pair is out. Remaining bowlers will be randomly assigned lanes and bowl 1 game. Again the low person on the pair is out. This is repeated until there is one person remaining in each division –

All Sole Survivors will win scholarships; others will be awarded scholarships 1 in 10 depending on the number of entries.

GHCPA Survivor Tournament – 2011 Rules

- 1) All participants must hold current 2010-2011 USBC Youth membership. Membership cards must be presented at check-in. Deadline for entries and check-in is 30 minutes before squad time.
 - 2) Average: Highest current average of 21 games or more as of MAY 1, 2011 from a USBC-certified league (USBC Rule 319a). **BOWLERS MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF AVERAGE BY COPY OF THE LEAGUE STANDING SHEET TO BOWL IN THE HANDICAP DIVISION.** If there is no average verification at the time of bowling, the bowler must bowl scratch.
 - 3) Divisions: There are four divisions: Boys Handicap, Girls Handicap, Boys Scratch, Girls Scratch.
 - 4) Handicap: Based on 100% of 200.
 - 5) Format:

Qualifier: Bowl four games across 2 pairs of lanes. Starting lane is randomly assigned. Top 50% of qualifiers in each division will advance to the **SURVIVOR FINALS.**

Survivor Finals: (Approximately 45 minutes following completion of the qualifier – all bowlers are responsible for knowing whether they have qualified for the finals.) Bowl 1 game on a pair of lanes with others in your division, lanes are randomly assigned. Depending on numbers, bowlers within a division may be divided to more than one pair. Handicap will be added in the handicap divisions. The low person on each pair is out. Remaining bowlers will be randomly assigned lanes and bowl 1 game. Again the low person on a pair is out. This is repeated until there is one person remaining in each division –

- 6) Entry Fee and Scholarships: Entry Fee is \$35 per bowler. \$15 lineage, \$4 expenses, and \$16 scholarship fund. Make checks payable to GHUSBC. Scholarships will be awarded 1 in 10 entries per division minimum. All scholarship fees will be returned 100%. The scholarship funds will be administered by the USBC SMART program.
 - 7) Dress Code: Appropriate dress will be required for all bowlers. NO BIKER SHORTS, SPANDEX SHORTS, CUTOFF PANTS, TANK TOPS, HALTER-TOPS, or MINI-SKIRTS are allowed. NO CLOTHING WITH REFERENCES TO SEX, RACE, DRUGS, or ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE ALLOWED. All shirts must have sleeves and be able to be tucked in, but do not have to be (NO BARE MIDRIFTS). All decisions on dress code by the tournament director shall be final.
 - 8) USBC rules, regulations, and codes will govern this tournament, and the tournament will be USBC certified.
